Rose Fugazzi--

Baptised in St Mathew's Church now a Cathedral used for the funeral mass of John F Kennedy. Rose attended St Matthew's elementary school until the sixth grade leaving to help her mother Anna Brignole-Fugazzi raise the other children. Rose wanted to be a seamstress but not allowed to apprentice. Intelligent, reading and writing in both English and Italian. When Luigi Giovanni Fugazzi brought the family back to Italy Rose was 15. At time mother, Anna, was strick and thought dancing was sinful making Rose's life miserable. John, Rose's younger brother would snitch on her activities causing Rose to take a beating. At 18 Rose married Romeo Fugazzi age 24. He promised to take Rose back to America which he did three days after they married in 1905, although he so loved Italy and the new home he had helped his father to build. Rose lived her adult life in Greenwich Village, NY working at home during WWI while raising Juliet her first daughter. Rose designed and assembled artificial flowers and feathers for women's accessories. Also remained home with her second daughter Rita born after the war 1920. Only after Rita started grade school did Rose work outside the home working at Sharf's Restaurant and later became an assistant dietitian at the VS Hospital in Bronx NY. In 1947 Rose and Romeo returned to Villa Caselle, Italy. After WWII roads were built connecting Ville Caselle with other small towns to the main highways. Rose and Romeo spent theire retiement between the coastal resort of Chiavari and their

Ville, Caselle 9 Alegrezzi, Aveto, (Genoe), Italy home were she died of an apoplectic stroke

Rose had a passport #34260 issued Jul 24, 1958 from Genoa, Italy cancelled and forwarded to Dept of State as decedent. Rose was a recipient of a pension from SS.

Notes for Romeo Teodoro Fugazzi:

Romeo Teodore Fugazzi - 5 ft 10 inches and very strong. Carried stones out of the mountains to help build family home in Caselle, Italy. Came to United States three days after his wedding to Rose in 1905. Sponsered by Eugenio Fugazzi set Rose and Romeo up in the grocery business in DC - but his temperment was not good so they moved to NY city where his brother Paul and family were living. Went to Italy in 1912 to visit. Romeo was drafted into the Italian army and did not returned until 1919. Romeo was with the Alpine Regiment of the Italian Army which was sent to Russia the night of the Armistice of 11/11/1918, regiment then shipped to England and where shipped to Archangel Russia. The regiment stayed in Siberia 6 months Romeo was 38 of age at this time. Became an American Citizen 1934. He and Rose lived in Greenwich Village, Manhattan, NY and a home in the Bronx were he had his vegetable garden. He returned to Casella in 1949 for his retirement, living in the home he had built along with his brothers. Later Romeo 85 old about 1965 was notified from Italian gov he could claim his WWI pension, at this time he found out his name was Romeo Teodoro Focacci.
