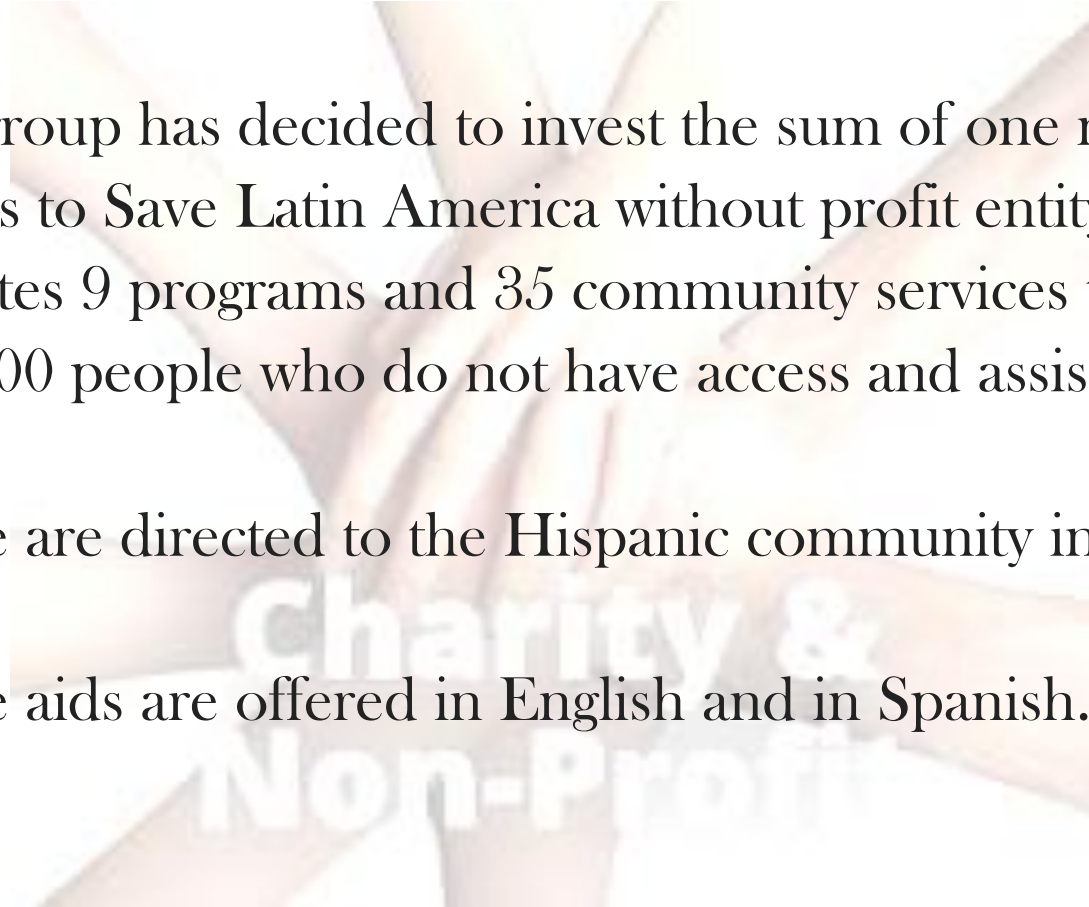


Save Latin America
